Key Features of the International Student Programme

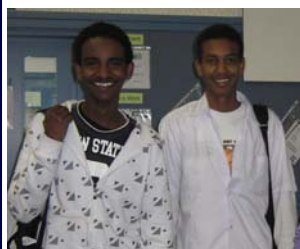
- English is available from beginners through to mainstream New Zealand English classes.
